


What is Wave Intercom?

Wave Intercom enables communication via cellular data, offering two types of communication.

Geo Wave

Open communication based on the distance between users




Wave Zone


All users within 1 miles (1.6 kilometers) are connected.

Friends Wave

Private communication among selected users




How to Start Geo Wave



- 1. Open the Wave Intercom App.
- 2. Start Wave Intercom by double tapping the Mesh Intercom button on your compatible Sena device.
- 3. When the map appears, you can start talking to anyone using Wave Intercom.
- 4. You can switch between Wave Intercom and Mesh Intercom by tapping the Jog Dial or the Center button once.


*Note: You can also start by tapping the **Geo Wave** button in the App.

How to Start Friends Wave



Start on Friends Tab


- Tap the Create
 Friends Wave button on the Friends Tab.
- 2. Select the people you want to chat with.
- 3. Tap the **Start** button.



Instant Start from Geo Wave

- Tap the **Grouping** button on the Geo Wave map.
- The Friends Wave will be instantly created with users within the Wave Zone.

How to Add Friends on Wave Intercom




- 1. Go to the Friends tab.
- 2. Tap 😝, and then 🖶 in the upper right corner.
- 3. Scan the QR code on your friend's screen.

What's good about adding friends?


- Even if you move out of the Wave Zone, the connection won't drop.
- The Wave Zone extends to a 1-mile(1.6-km) radius.
- Users who're not on your Friends list will lose connection beyond a 2-mile (3.2-km) radius.







Start Geo Wave Intercom




- 1. Open the App.
- 2. Double tap the Mesh Intercom button on your device, or tap the **Geo Wave** button on the screen.
- 3. A map will appear.
- 4. Now you can talk to anyone within the circle.

End Wave Intercom






- Single tap the Mesh button on your device, or tap the End button on the screen.
- 2. Tap Yes to confirm.



- Tap the Add as a Friend button.




Search nicknames

- 1. Tap in the upper right corner.
- 2. Enter the username and tap the **Add** button.




QR code



- 1. Tap in the upper right corner.
- 2. Tap in the upper right corner.
- 3. Scan your friend's QR code to automatically send a request.

Create a Friends Wave











- 1. Go to the Friends tab and tap the **Create Friends Wave** button.
- 2. Navigate the tabs to select the members.
- 3. Tap the **Start** button and wait until the process is complete.
- 4. Start the conversation when the map appears.


*Note: You can choose the members from three different tabs.



Nearby users within the wave zone




Friends previously added friends

Switch to Friends Wave from Geo Wave




- Tap the **Grouping** button on the Geo Wave map.
- 2. The Friends Wave will be instantly created with the users within the Wave Zone.

^{*}Note: Only the users on your Friends list can be grouped. Users who are in the wave zone but not on your Friends list won't be joined through this process.

Add new members to the group


You can still invite new members to the existing group after starting a conversation.



- 1. Tap (\$\text{R}^{20/20}\$) in the upper right corner.
- 2. Tap the **Invite** button on the right.
- 3. Select the people you want to chat with.
- 4. Tap the **Invite** button at the bottom.

Resend the invitation


You can reinvite members who haven't responded to the invitations yet.




- Tap a profile picture on the left panel.
- 2. Tap Yes to confirm.
- *Note: The left panel shows users who haven't joined the conversation. The icons indicate two types of status.
- 3 dots: The member hasn't responded to your invitation.
- Single dot in the bottom right: The member has joined the group but is not in the conversation now.

Restart a Friends Wave

Once you've joined a Friends Wave, it will be listed in the History tab. You can restart the conversation with the same group anytime.





1. Tap the group you want to chat with.




2. Tap the **Friends Wave** button.

Share your Friends Wave









- 1. Swipe up the bottom sheet or tap (\$\mathbb{R}^{20/20}\$) in the upper right corner.
- Tap and share the generated link.

*Note: Using the bottom sheet, You can toggle off to expire the link or regenerate the link by tapping ⑤.


Customize your Friends Wave






When you're in a Friends Wave

- Swipe up the bottom sheet.
- 2. Tap ② to change the group name or ⑤ to change the profile picture.






When creating a Friends Wave

- Tap in the upper right corner.
- 2. Tap 2 to change the group name or 5 to change the profile picture.

Check your location on the map

There are two types of compass icons in the bottom right corner to show your location on the map. You can switch the icons by tapping them.



Relocate to your current location

If you zoom, rotate, and pan the map to check the surrounding areas, the compass icon will turn into Are-center.



- Tap the Re-center button.
- 2. The map will adjust to show your current location.
